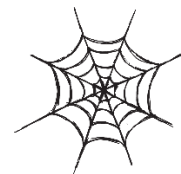
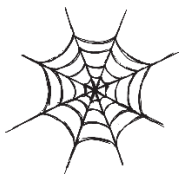

Classes

Start time 9.30 am

Class 1: Nanny and Novice approx height 50cm

Entry Fee per pair: £60 Prizes in kind (1st to 3rd), rosettes to 6th place & prizes for the best Halloween dressed pair

Class 2: Minimus (over a shortened course) approx height 50cm *

Entry fee: £20 Rosettes to all on completion of the course & prizes for the best Halloween dressed rider and horse

Class 3: Novice (approx height 75cm)*

Entry fee £30 Prizes in kind (1st to 3rd), rosettes to 6th place & prizes for the best Halloween dressed rider and horse

Class 3 will be split between juniors and seniors

Class 4 Open (approx height 100cm)*

Entry fee £30 Prizes in kind (1st to 3rd), rosettes to 6th place & prizes for the best Halloween dressed rider and horse

Class 5: Team Challenge: Pairs*, team of 3, team of 4 pick & mix fences 70cm-90cm

Entry fee £30 per person Rosettes to all on completion of the course & prizes for the best Halloween dressed rider and horse

PLEASE NOTE: There is a £3 Medical Cover charge per rider which has been included in the entry fee.

*** The top 3 places in classes 2, 3 and 4 will qualify for Eland Lodge National Hunter Trial Championships. The Team Challenge will only be competitive for pairs entries with the top 3 also qualifying for Eland Lodge. Teams of 3 and 4 will be non-competitive.**



Numbers bibs will NOT be provided so please ensure you bring your own. Each rider/pair will be issued with their own competitor number when the times are released. You will need to print these numbers clearly on A4 paper to display in your number bibs front and back. Both pairs riders MUST wear bib numbers.

TIMES will be allocated for all classes and will be available online at www.darrowbyrc.co.uk on Thursday 28th October after 7pm.

LATE ENTRIES: Entries close Monday 25th October – late entries will only be accepted if classes are not full.

COURSE WALK: The course will be available for walking after 2pm, no earlier on Saturday 30th October 2021. Riders will also be allowed to walk the course on the day of the competition.
